

## Making a Thumbprint Poster

1. Using an inkpad, help each of the children to ink their thumb and then carefully press their thumbprint on a poster.
2. Write the children's initials directly below each thumbprint.
3. When all the children have added their thumbprints, gather the children around the poster.
4. Allow them time to note similarities and differences. Emphasize that no two thumbprints are the same.
5. Tell the children that although we are all different, we all share something important: We are made in the image and likeness of God.
6. Have the children help you to think of a title for their thumbprint poster
