Charting Good Samaritan Actions

- 1. Before class draw a grid on a poster, with each child's name in a column on the left. Purchase a generous supply of stickers for the children to use.
- 2. Show the children the chart and the stickers.
- 3. Remind the children that in Chapter 23, they learned that Jesus asks us to be good neighbors.
- 4. Ask for examples of ways they can be good neighbors in class, at home, in school, and in the neighborhood.
- 5. Tell the children to keep track of the times they act as good neighbors during the coming week. Announce that they may add a sticker next to their name for each time they live as
- 6. During your next session, allow time for the children to share their "Good Samaritan" experiences with the class and add stickers next to their name for each instance.
