- The Story of Salvation

 1. The young people have learned many Scripture stories over the past five years, but they may not have a full understanding of how they connect. This unit began with the story of Abraham, our father in faith. The following Scripture passages will help them see a patern to the story—from Adam and Eve's sin to the coming of the Messiah.

 2. Distribute Bibles and divide the students into five groups. Assign just one passage to each group, as some of the stories are long.

 Genesis 3 (The Fall of Man)

 Genesis 9: 1-17 (The Covenant with Noah)

 Exodus 19: 1-8 (God's Covenant with Moses)

 2 Samuel 7: 1-17 (God's Promises to King David)

 Luke 1: 26-38 (Announcement of the Birth of Jesus)

 3. Tell each group to read their passage, and then discuss the following questions:

 What do we learn about God in each passage?

 What verse or verses are most important for us to remember?

 4. Invite each group to tell the class what their passage was about and how they answered the two questions.
