

Learning about the Stations of the Cross

- 1. Ask an adult to take you to church to look at the Stations of the Cross. You can also plan to stay after Mass.
- 2. Slowly stop and look at each Station. Talk with the adult about what each station represents.
- 3. If possible, bring a camera and take a picture of each Station. Then you can review the Stations at home. You might like to post a picture of your favorite Station where you can see it often.
- 4. If you do not have a camera, draw a picture of your favorite Station.
- 5. If you need assistance trying to figure out what each Station represents, use the list below.

The Stations of the Cross

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death.
- 2. Jesus accepts his cross.
- 3. Jesus falls the first time.
- 4. Jesus meets his mother.
- 5. Simon helps Jesus carry the cross.
- 6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus.
- 7. Jesus falls the second time.
- 8. Jesus meets the women.
- 9. Jesus falls the third time.
- 10. Jesus is stripped of his clothes.
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the cross.
- 12. Jesus dies on the cross.
- 13. Jesus is taken down from the cross.
- 14. Jesus is buried in the tomb.
- 15. Jesus rises from the dead.
