

We Live the Moral Virtues

1. Divide the class into four small groups.
2. Assign one of the Cardinal Virtues—prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance—to each group.
3. Instruct each group to work together to create a skit about someone their age living their assigned virtue.
4. If necessary, allow the students to consult their texts for a description of each of the Cardinal Virtues.
5. Allow time for the students to prepare their skits. Afterward, invite each group to perform their skit for the class.
6. Conclude by reminding the class that the Cardinal Virtues help to form one's conscience so that each of us can live as a disciple of Jesus.
