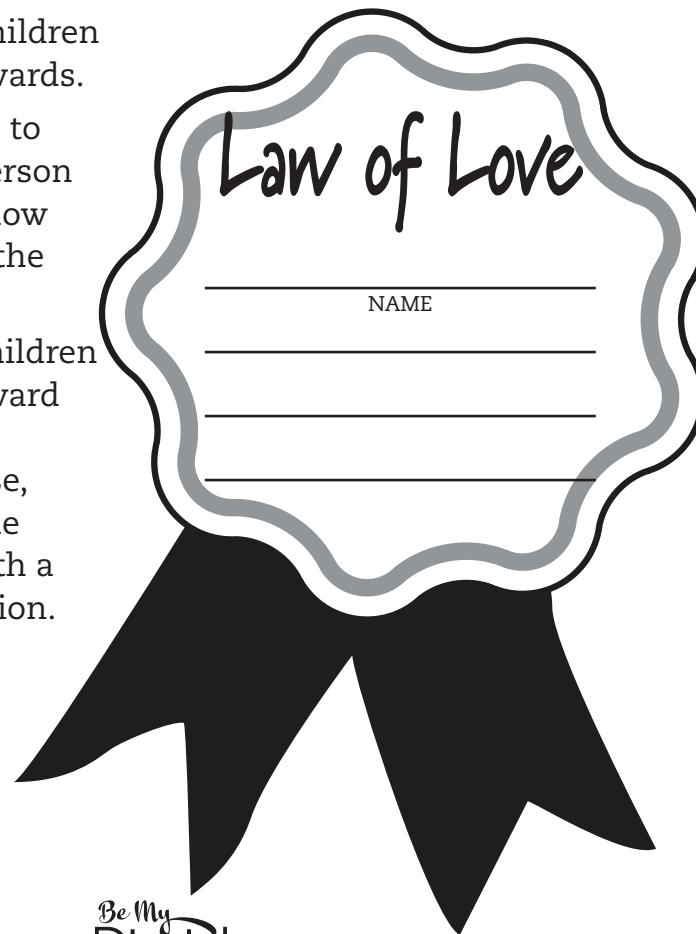


The Law of Love Award

1. Distribute the award hand-out. Have the children cut it out.
2. Tell the children to think of someone they know—a relative, neighbor, or classmate, parish leader—who lives the Law of Love.
3. If necessary, have the students review Ch. 19 to recall what the Law of Love teaches.
4. Invite the children to print the name of the person they think of on the line and a description of how the individual lives the Law of Love in the space provided.
5. Then have the children decorate their awards.
6. Invite volunteers to introduce the person they chose and how the person lives the Law of Love.
7. Encourage the children to present the award personally to the person they chose, or to mail it to the person, along with a written explanation.
