The Be My Disciples Summer Program Contract

Background

The Be My Disciples Summer Program Contract is a method for opening up the shared responsibility of passing on the faith, which exists between the parish and the household. The contract is especially appropriate for parishes choosing the Two-Week + At Home Model for the Summer Program. Based on the work of Bill Huebsch (The 50-50 Covenant, © PastoralPlanning. com 2006), the contract makes clear the roles and expectations of parents, families, catechists, and the parish.

What the Parish Might Promise

Here's an example of what the parish might promise. Any given parish may promise all of these items, some of them, or others which fit into their culture and parish spirit.

As a Parish:

- We promise to offer catechetical gatherings that give faithful instruction about the fundamentals of the Catholic faith.
- We promise to use materials approved by the local bishop and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).
- We promise to make sure that catechists and volunteers who are well prepared for their ministry facilitate all Summer Program sessions held at the parish.
- We promise to offer you, the parents and families, opportunities to gather for information and formational gatherings that will assist you in both teaching and living your faith in the home.

 We promise to do everything possible to offer help, prayerful support, and resources needed to help guide you and those who live within your household in the Catholic way of life, a life based on Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, prayer and worship, and service.

As a Family:

- We promise to complete the third week of the Three-Week Summer Program in our home, following the schedule outlined by the catechist and Summer Program director.
- We promise to use the materials provided, which have been chosen by the parish and approved by the local bishop and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).
- We promise to attend the informational and formational gatherings held in relation to the *Be My Disciples* Summer Program.
- We promise to continue to growing in our Catholic faith by: attending Sunday Mass on a regular basis; praying as a family; doing works of charity and service together; and continuing to learn about our Catholic faith.

Suggested Format

A suggested format for the contract follows. Again, please note that the content of the contract should reflect your *Be My Disciples* Summer Program structure, schedule, and expectations. Also take into consideration what is do-able for the parents and families. You do not want to overwhelm them with too many expectations. You do, however, want to help them recognize and take responsibility for their child's faith formation.

- **6.** We promise to be available to meet with you, respond to your questions and concerns, and support you in any way possible as you share the responsibility of forming your child(ren) in the faith of the Church.
